TOUR DETAIL

20/09/19 - Yokoso! Welcome to Japan

Your Japan adventure begins with your arrival into Sapporo, where KSG staff will meet you after you've cleared customs and immigration. We'll transfer you to your hotel, and then you're free to explore the local sights and flavours after check-in. Try Hokkaido's famous 'Genghis Khan' for dinner, and cook lamb and veggies on a huge domed grill set into your table! You can try this at the Kirin Beer Garden and other spots all over town.

Meals included: Breakfast.

21/09/19 - Match Day: Australia v. Fiji, Sapporo Dome, 13:45

Free morning for exploring! Ride the Sapporo Streetcar (shiden) for a leisurely glimpse of everyday life in Sapporo, stopping at the 'Tanuki-koji' covered-arcade shopping street, heart of the neighbourhood. A mid-day bus transfer takes you to ultra high-tech Sapporo Dome for the afternoon match. We transfer you back to your hotel by bus following this and all matches. **Meals Included: Breakfast.**

22/09/19 - Match Day: England v. Tonga, Sapporo Dome, 19:15

You're free all day for relaxed sightseeing until the evening match. Check out the Sapporo Autumn Fest, a sprawling food and beverage celebration at several hubs all along Odori Park. Just outside the hotel, take a walk through Nakajima Park, where you'll find a lake with rowboats for hire and a traditional Japanese garden complete with a vintage thatched-roof teahouse.

Meals included: Breakfast.

23/09/19 - Sapporo Tour

Make the rounds of central Sapporo, including Shiroi Koibito Park and chocolate factory and Odori Park, actually the huge median strip of the main east-west avenue running through town spanning 1.5 + kilometres. Stop at the Clock Tower, a Boston import dating from 1878, symbol of Sapporo and its oldest building. Visit the Sapporo Beer museum, a Hokkaido Heritage site, and get to know Japanese beer first-hand. See Hokkaido's pristine seafood up close at the Outer Wholesale Market, open to the public and selling souvenirs as well as delicacies to eat right on the spot. **Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch.**

24/09/19 - Free Day to explore Sapporo

So many things still left to do and see! Try your hand at curling at the Hokkaido Bank Curling Stadium, with free lessons and affordable rentals. Or explore Mt. Moiwa and Moiwa Primeval Forest, a vast nature reserve within the city. Take it easy and ride the cable car up, or hike up for a bit of exercise. The night view from the top of Mt. Moiwa is considered one of the "three most beautiful night views" in Japan. **Meals included: Breakfast.**

25/09/19 - Transfer to Tokyo

Say goodbye to the vast open spaces of Hokkaido as we return to the bright lights and big city of Tokyo. Bus transfer from hotel to airport, and again from airport to hotel. Following Tokyo check-in, you are free to explore on your own for the rest of the day. **Meals included: Breakfast.**

26/09/19 - Free Day to explore Tokyo

The day is yours to explore the wonders of Tokyo. Get up early to see the daily fish market at Tsukiji, walk through famous Kaminari-mon (Thunder Gate) at Asakusa and pay a visit to Senso-ji Temple, cross the world's busiest intersection at Shinjuku Crossing, or visit the National Sumo Hall at Ryogoku Kokugikan and then head to a nearby restaurant and order some 'chanko nabe' stew that pro sumo wrestlers eat. Take an Ikebana class, check out a cat cafe or hit some balls at a multi-story driving range, the once-in-a-lifetime possibilities are endless.

Meals included: Breakfast.

27/09/19 - Mt. Fuji Tour

Fuji-san, as it is commonly known, is the highlight of the day. Japan's tallest peak and an active volcano, it is the beloved symbol of the nation and a sacred mountain. Travel by bus to Lake Kawaguchi, serene reflecting pool for Fuji-san, then meander around the Oshino Eight Ponds for views of Fuji-san as a backdrop for traditional, rural scenery. Meet up with ninjas at the Oshino Ninja Village then enjoy lunch prepared with local ingredients before heading up to Fuji-san's 5th station (out of 10). Return to Tokyo by bus in time for dinner on your own.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch.

28/09/19 - Tokyo A to Z Tour

From Harajuku, mecca of pop culture, walk through giant wooden torii gates into the sacred forest of Meiji-jingu, a Shinto shrine dedicated to the Meiji emperor. Visit the world's tallest tower, Tokyo Skytree, and walk along the glass-floored Tembo Galleria at 450 metres above ground. Next stop is the Imperial palace and garden, with buildings and gardens dating from the Edo period. Fast-forward in time and leave tranquillity behind as we drop in on the vibrant and pulsating Akihabara anime and electric town.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch.

29/09/19 - Match Day: Australia v. Wales, Tokyo Stadium 16:45

You're free until the afternoon match, and this is a good time to visit the area surrounding historic Tokyo station, or take a boat tour along the Sumida River, or stroll through upscale Ginza for shopping and traditional green tea in a modern setting. Evening bus transfer back to the hotel to prepare your large luggage for sending in advance, so you can travel tomorrow with your KSG provided carry-on case. Finish early and head out to karaoke on your last night in Tokyo! **Meals included: Breakfast.**

30/09/19 - Transfer to Hiroshima

Today your Western Japan adventure begins as we travel by Shinkansen (Bullet Train) to Hiroshima. 'Eki-ben' (nickname for o-bento lunch boxes from different stations) are different all over the country, and eating a bento box lunch on the Bullet Train is a favourite activity in Japan. Relax like a native and take in the changing scenery as we zip along at speeds of nearly 300 km/hour! Your luggage will be waiting for you on arrival at your hotel. **Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch pack.**

1/10/19 - Hiroshima Tour

Site of the world's first atomic bombing, the city of Hiroshima is now a symbol of the wish for world peace. Visit the Peace Memorial Park, then board a ferry to exquisite and iconic Miyajima Island, site of the 'floating' red torii gate in front of Itsukushima Shrine. On the island, feed wild deer and walk through the gorgeous and sprawling shrine jutting out over the water. Return by ferry and visit the Kobo Brush Museum in the small town of Kumano, just east of Hiroshima, and make your own calligraphy



brush. **Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch.**

2/10/19 - Free Day

The day is yours to explore on your own. Ride the 'Hiroden' streetcar around town and visit the five-story Hiroshima castle, a reconstruction of the original built in 1589. Just east of the castle is Shukkei-en Garden, where mountains, valleys, forests and lakes are recreated in miniature. Be on the lookout for okonomiyaki, the signature dish of the region, and Hiroshima's famous oysters, which are excellent year-round. In the evening, find a neighbourhood izakaya, Japan's version of a pub, and settle in for small plates ordered one at a time to pair with your sake tastings, and some of the best comes from near Hiroshima. **Meals include: Breakfast.**

3/10/19 - Transfer to Fukuoka

Today you'll visit the third of the four main islands as we depart Hiroshima by bus bound for Fukuoka, a coastal town facing the Sea of Japan on the northwest coast of Kyushu. **Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch Pack.**

4/10/19 - Fukuoka Free Day

Head off to the beach at Momochi-hama, a pristine, man-made beach at the foot of Fukuoka Tower, great for swimming and beach volleyball. Or visit the tiny island of Shikanoshima by ferry. It's connected to the mainland by an 8 km by 2.5 km strip of land, and the sandy beaches all along this stretch are popular spots to enjoy sand and sea. Prefer an indoor plan? Visit the Fukuoka Museum to be entranced by the history of the city with a pre-modern look at Japan. Have a Zen moment at Shojuku-ji Temple, the first Zen temple built in Japan, circa 1195. Come evening, don't miss Fukuoka's yatai: small, casual food stalls seating around 6 to 8 people. Find them lined up along the waterside, especially at Nakasu. Wander along, leisurely eating and drinking your way down the row!

Meals included: Breakfast.

5/10/19 - Match Day: Australia v. Uruguay, Oita Stadium, 14:15

After breakfast a chartered bus carries you off in style to Oita Stadium to watch Australia v Americas 2. After the match you'll be transferred back to Fukuoka. Prepare your large luggage to send in advance, and be prepared to travel with your KSG provided carry-on case.

Meals included: Breakfast.

6/10/19 - Transfer to Kyoto

Depart Fukuoka on the bullet train to Kyoto, the Old Capital. Head out for a walk and breathe in the soft Kyoto air as you get your bearings around town. Head east from the hotel to the Kamo River, turn left to walk upstream, then head back west when you get to Sanjo-dori (3rd street) to get the feel of classic Kyoto. You're free to explore on your own the whole day. **Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch.**

7/10/19 - Western Kyoto Tour

Explore western Kyoto today as we stop in at Kinkakuji, the 'Golden Pavilion,' then get your Zen on as you gaze at Japan's most famous rock garden at Ryoan-ji. Head out of the city to Arashiyama and visit Tenryu-ji, a sprawling Zen temple compound dating to 1339, with gorgeous gardens and teahouses. End your day in awe as you traverse paths cutting through towering bamboo in the dark and mysterious Arashiyama Bamboo Forest.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch Pack.

8/10/19 - Match Day: South Africa v. Canada, Kobe Misaki Stadium, 19:15

Enjoy a free day and nibble your way through historic Nishiki Market, an open-air food extravaganza under an arcade of stained glass. Go early; it gets crowded by mid-day. See the Museum of Kyoto, housed in an old bank building, and catch up on the history of the city and the July Gion Festival. Peek in on the excellent, elegant coffee shop in what used to be the vault. Don't miss the International Manga Museum, and browse four floors of illustrated comics, definitely not just for kids! In between are teahouses, coffee shops and small cafes galore to keep you going before the evening match. Round trip to the picturesque harbour town of Kobe by chartered bus.

Meals included: Breakfast.

9/10/19 - Nara Tour

Today we visit nearby Nara, Japan's first permanent capital and cultural treasure chest. Meet the Great Buddha at Tōdai-ji temple, see hundreds of deer in Nara Park, and experience Kasuga Grand Shrine, protectorate of the Fujiwara Clan. More than 3,000 lanterns line the walk approaching the shrine, one for each of the 3,000 Kasuga shrines throughout the country. Like many Shintō shrines, Kasuga Grand Shrine is nestled in a sacred grove, and countless small wooden shrines and mossy, ancient stone lanterns dot the maze of paths through the forest.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch



10/10/19 - Transfer to Hamamatsu by bus and spend the afternoon exploring the area. Head over to Lake Hamana and rent a bicycle to stretch your legs on the 48km bicycle lakeside path, then drop in at one of the onsen along the lake and have a relaxing soak in the therapeutic spring waters. If you want to stay in the downtown area, the Hamamatsu Castle and surrounding cherry tree gardens provide a good mix of martial history and stunning beauty. Or visit the Hamamatsu Museum of Musical Instrument, with traditional Japanese instruments as well as others from around the world, some of which you may play. **Meals included: Breakfast.**

11/10/19 - Tour and Match Day: Australia v. Georgia, Shizuoka Stadium Ecopa, 19:15

After breakfast, we go on a half-day tour around the stunning Hamamatsu Flower Park, a 30,000 square metre botanical garden with more than 3,000 species of plants. In October, roses and amethyst sage are beginning to take centre stage. Later that afternoon we go by bus to Shizuoka Stadium Ecopa for an evening match. **Meals included: Breakfast.**

12/10/19 - Today we say Sayonara as the tour comes to a close (*). A chartered bus delivers you to either Narita or Haneda airport. Cosmos flowers should be in full bloom, and will make for some lovely final scenery as they wave in the breeze to you as you pass along the highway.

Meals included: Breakfast.

(*). Should you wish to extend your tour we have an optional 2 night Tokyo Add-on, and the following can be added to your escorted tour.

12/10/19 - Match Day: England v. France, International Stadium Yokohama, 17:15

After a morning checkout from Hamamatsu, you'll transfer by bus to Tokyo for a two-night extended tour. We travel to the International Stadium Yokohama for the afternoon match. Before the game you can sample some of the best ramen from all over Japan in one place - the Shin Yokohama Ramen Museum serves up the exhibits in a replica streetscape of Tokyo's Shitamachi ("downtown") of the 1950's. **Meals included: Breakfast.**

13/10/19 - Match Day: Japan v. Scotland, International Stadium Yokohama, 19:45

After breakfast you have a free day to see something new in Tokyo before we travel back to Yokohama for the evening match. October in Tokyo means Oktoberfest, and beer gardens and many other festivals can be found all over the city. You might just get caught up in a local neighbourhood parade as you make your way around town! **Meals included: Breakfast.**

14/10/19 - Today we say Sayonara as the tour comes to a close (*). A chartered bus delivers you either Narita or Haneda airport. Cosmos flowers should be in full bloom, and will make for some lovely final scenery as they wave in the breeze to you as you pass along the highway. **Meals included: Breakfast.**
